"Skills Shortage" - The Statement of the Year

The new financial year for 2010 is quickly turning into the desperate times of 2007 when "skills shortage" seemed to be the statement of the year.

In a recent survey of 400 companies employing over 30,000 people across the manufacturing, services and construction sector reported:

- 4 in 5 businesses believe that skills shortages will affect them in 2010
- 27.4% of all vacancies over the past 6 months remain unfilled
- Two thirds of companies had difficulties filling vacancies over the past 6 months
- 59.3% commented "lack of specialised skills available" and 48.5% stated "lack of applicants" as to the reason for these unfilled vacancies
- Companies are responding with 37.8% "up skilling existing staff" and 31.2% "outsourcing or subcontracting the work"

The way out of this crisis the last time was for candidates to increase their skill level and seek opportunities that will boost these skills and experience.
